For all grades - To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

1. You must earn a **minimum of 10 points** from **FALL 2018** grades
 - a. The first **4 points** must be from LIST I (*unless you are a senior applying for membership in Spring semester*).
 - b. The first **7 points** (including the 4 described in "a") must be from LIST I or LIST I and II.
 - c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, or III).
 - d. **One additional point shall be granted for an AP or Honors course with a grade of A or B to qualify for the total 10 points required (up to a maximum of two such points per semester).**
2. You must use **no more than 5 courses** to qualify.
3. **No CSF points** are given for physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, course involving clerking and office/teaching assistant, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - Grade of **A = 3 CSF points** (*note: a grade of A in an AP or honors course earns 4 CSF points*)
 - Grade of **B = 1 CSF point** (*note: a grade of B in an AP or honors course earns 2 CSF points*)
 - Grade of **C = 0 CSF points**
 - Grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, **disqualifies** you for membership at this time.
5. You must attach a **copy of your unofficial transcript from Infinite Campus** as a verification of your coursework and grades.
